



## RUSH SAILING CLUB REGATTA

### Notice of Race

#### 1. RULES

This event will be governed by the 2017-2020 ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the Irish Sailing Association, the Class rules and the Sailing Instructions. The organising authority is Rush Sailing Club.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY

All boats must be in a position to produce a valid Class Certificate. Eligible boats may enter by completing the Entry Form and submitting the required entry fee.

#### 3. ENTRY PROCEDURE

Registration will take place in the Clubhouse on Saturday 8th from 09.00 to 10.00. The entry fee will be as follows

**Cost of entry - €50 Mermaids, €20 Toppers, Lasers**

Competitors may enter by completing the entry form, which will be available on [www.rushsc.ie](http://www.rushsc.ie) or at the Rush Sailing Club Race Office, and paying the entry fee by cash or bank transfer to the RSC Main Club account

##### 3.1 Entry Disclaimer

It is the Competitor's decision to enter the event or to start in any race. Competitors shall accept that their participation in the event is at their sole exclusive risk in every respect. By way of entry to the event competitors shall indemnify Rush Sailing Club, their officers, members, servants and agents in respect of all claims and demands of whatever nature which may be made upon them in connection with or howsoever arising from their participation or intended participation in the event. Competitors shall acknowledge that Rush Sailing Club, their officers, members, servants and agents accept no responsibility in respect of loss of life, personal injury or loss or damage to property which may be sustained by reason of their participation or intended participation in the event or howsoever arising in connection with these events.

### 3.2 Insurance

All boats shall have third party insurance cover of not less than €3,000,000 (or the equivalent thereof in any other convertible currency) for any accident. All owners / competitors who sign the entry forms are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover. Owners / competitors not holding this cover shall withdraw their entry.

\*At the discretion of the race officer, Laser and Toppers may have a combined start depending on the number of boats.

Optimists will Race on Sunday in the river. Optimist sailors should attend the club and will have a briefing at 10:30am of the days activities.
